## ***PeeWee Tornados Win 3<sup>rd</sup> Place at Pre-Christmas Tournament in Surrey, B.C.***

**Surrey Sport and Leisure Complex, Surrey, B.C., Canada 22 December, 2009** – The Kent Valley PeeWee Tornados participated in a pre-Christmas tournament in Surrey, B.C., December 20<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup>. The Tornados played seven games in three days, winning 5 and losing 2, and walking away with a third place showing overall. Following is a summary of each game:

**12/20 Game 1: Kent Valley Tornados (1) vs. Cloverdale Warriors (2)** – The Tornados' only goal was scored by Mason Conner, unassisted, in the closing seconds of the final period. The two Warriors' goals were scored in the first and second periods. Shots were not recorded. Each team had one minor penalty.

**12/20 Game 2: Kent Valley Tornados (6) vs. Cloverdale Mustangs (1)** – The Cloverdale Mustangs managed only one goal against the Tornados and that score came near the end of the second period. The Tornados dominated the first period with 4 goals and added one goal in each of the other two periods. Shots were not recorded. Each team had two minor penalties.

Cloverdale scared the Tornados with an early goal just 1:37 into the first period. However, the Tornados recovered quickly and tied it up at 7:45 of the first when Nick Pizze scored with an assist from Landon Bevier. Two quick unanswered Tornados goals in the second period pretty much sealed the deal for the Kent Valley PeeWees. Nick Pizze scored at 1:15

into the second period with an assist from Jake Best. Pizzey and Best teamed up again less than two minutes later to score the Tornadoes' third goal and earn Pizzey a Hat Trick. At 11:53 of the final period, Jake Best put icing on the Bronze Medal cake for the Tornadoes with an unassisted goal. And, that concluded the Kent Valley PeeWee Tornadoes 3<sup>rd</sup> place win.

Congratulations Tornadoes! Well done, and enjoy the victory. It isn't very often we Americans bring home medals from a Canadian tournament.
